



Metro Gold Line Wins the Gold

IAC America has fabricated and installed a sound barrier for the Pasadena Metro Gold Line project in California. The light rail transit line is approximately 13 miles long and extends from Union Station in the city of Los Angeles to Sierra Madre Villa Boulevard in the city of Pasadena.

“After years of litigation it is great to see that this beautiful community will be a quieter place” according to IAC technical sales representative Gus Sauter of CE Pickup company.

The project includes more than 1200 IAC Noishield® FS barrier panels. The 5” thick panel is self-draining and the absorptive side is rated NRC 1.05. The rugged panel is easy to install and is available in 24” and 18” heights and up to 16 feet long. The panels endure a five step cleaning process and are factory finished with a tough, thermosetting polyester powder coat available in hundreds of colors and patterns to simulate wood and brick.

The steel panels are lighter and easier to install than traditional wood and concrete barriers and are ideal for ground, bridges, and roof top community noise control applications.
